Six jurisdictions expressly do not allow a change of trainer after the horse has been entered in a race. Two of these jurisdictions (Ohio, Indiana) extends the time until after it has been		

drawn into a race.

One jurisdiction limits the stewards approval of trainer transfers to **prior to entry** which likely has the same effect as the Model Rule.

Three jurisdictions have some reporting requirement regarding trainer changes which may act as a prohibition

15 jurisdictions hav a rule prohibiting alteration of entries which may be able to be used to restrict trainer changes after entry

In six jurisdictions no rule was found
