Except as otherwise provided in this Rule 2458, no horse claimed during an Oaklawn race meet shall be eligible to race at another track for a period of thirty (30) days following the end of the Oaklawn racing season unless the claimed horse has subsequently run back in another race at Oaklawn following the claim. Horses claimed during the final fifteen (15) scheduled race days of an Oaklawn race meet are excepted from the requirements of Rule 2458(a). Horses entered in good faith in a subsequent race at Oaklawn with appropriate conditions that are unable to run back before of failure of the subsequent race at Oaklawn to fill or failure to draw in from the also eligible list may be excepted from the requirements of Rule 2458(a), if approved by the Racing Secretary and Stewards. Horses also may be excused from the requirements of Rule 2458(a) with approval by the Racing Secretary and Stewards in other appropriate circumstances where the horse was unable for good cause to run back in a subsequent race at Oaklawn.

A horse that is claimed by an Owner that has started a horse at the current meet by a Trainer that is not currently stabled on the grounds of the Association shall not be permitted to race elsewhere until the close of the meeting which it was claimed. The Stewards shall have the authority to waive this rule upon application, so as to allow a claimed horse to race in a stakes race.
