MEDICATION EXPERT SPEAKKS TO THE ADVANCED RACING LAW **CLASS**



Tucson, AZ — Dr. Scott Stanley, a professor at the UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine, didn't let a travel issue get in the way of an informative lecture on medications and testing. He called an audible and spoke to RTIP students in the Advanced Animal Racing Laws and Enforcement class through a video lecture on Skype

Dr. Stanley described lab procedures and racing animal drug testing. He also discussed the legal processes involved with being an expert witness in court cases.

He went over different lab test and procedures used to find different drugs including gas chromatography and mass spectrometry. There was also discussion about

creating drug thresholds, doing confirmation testing, and dealing with split samples.
